

REGISTRATION PROCESS

We will continue to use the same online registration system as last season. We understand if some Team Organisers and/or Players may want to continue completing the registration form and then paying the registration fee's in person or through bank deposits, so we will also continue with these methods as well as offering the online system.

The online system enables Team Organisers to register their team and then players to register into the team. This process simplifies the Team Organiser's job and also makes it easier for players to register and pay their registration fees. There is no additional cost to register online.

In order to use the online system, you will be required to create a Sports TG Passport if you do not already have one. To create a passport, you will also require a valid email address.

Team Organisers – Online Registrations

If you organised a team during the Winter 2019 competition you will receive an email from us prompting you to register your team for Summer 2019-20. Please use this link as it will simplify the process substantially. If you did not receive this email or require your team code, please send us an email and we will forward you a new link.

To register a new team please go to: <https://membership.sportstg.com/regofrm.cgi?formID=75820> and select New Team Registration, then select Continue when it appears. Please complete the Team Registration form, filling in all mandatory fields (*). Please pay particular attention to your email address and contact number as we will use this to communicate with you.

Once you have registered the team you will receive an email with a link you need to supply to your players. This enables them to register themselves into your team, you will also need to register yourself into the team as well. You can register just yourself or as many of your players as you want through the player registration portal. You have the choice of paying online or you can still choose to pay in person or over the phone.

If you chose to not do your registration online you need to complete the registration paperwork in this kit.

Please note that until you have 8 players REGISTERED and PAID for into your team the team will not be considered registered into the competition.

To be clear, you can either register online with the above links OR you can complete the registration paperwork as per past seasons. We will take payments through the online registration process OR in person at the fields or via bank transfer or over the phone.

Representative/PremTag Player Rules

THESE RULES HAVE CHANGED FOR SUMMER 2019-20 SO PLEASE READ CAREFULLY

No exceptions for any team no matter how long they've been together, family members, keeping rep teams together or for any other reason.

In order to ensure our competitions, especially in the higher grades remain competitive we have updated the rep player limits and changed how they are applied. We understand this may impact some teams, resulting in some teams exceeding the limits. If this is the case you have 2 choices, either accept you will go to a higher grade or reduce the players to come in under the limit.

In order to try to maintain the competitiveness of our competitions, and to give all teams a fair go, we have rules in place on how many Representative players that are permitted in teams from Division 2 down. If you have any question regarding these rules, or how they may apply to your team or players please don't hesitate to contact us. We are always open to suggestions on improvements or tweaking of these rules, but they must be to everyone's benefits, so if you have any idea's please come and discuss them with us.

A **Rep player** is a person who has represented **ANY** Oztag competition at the previous **Senior State Cup (2019)** or **National Titles (2018)** or is a current **State** or **National** player.

Age is determined by the players age at scheduled start date of the respective competition.

- These limits do not dictate where teams **without** Rep Players are graded. Just because a team is under a limit it does not mean they cannot be placed in a high grade.
- In the event there is no PremTag, the Div 2 limit will apply to Div 1, Div 3 to Div 2 and so on.
- Players selected in a Penrith 2nd or 3rd rep team **DO NOT** count towards the rep player total
- Players who have **only** represented in a Junior Representative team **DO NOT** count towards the rep player total, but you must indicate if Junior Rep when registering.
- You **must indicate when registering if a player is a Rep Player**. This means a **Rep Player** at **ANY OZTAG** association. Any team found **not identifying** any rep players will be subject to sanctions as the committee decides; including **re-grading of the team or withdrawal of the player/s in question**.

Registrations

Registration day will be **Saturday 31st August 2019 (10.00am to 1.00pm)** at The Kingsway fields, or any **Tuesday/Wednesday/Thursday** evening of the current competition. You may also arrange to drop your registration form off to us by calling **0421448158** to organise a suitable time. You can also email the completed registration form (**penrith@oztag.com.au**) and deposit entry fees directly into bank (please put relevant details on the deposit so we can identify who it is for).

Closing date for team registrations is **Saturday 31st August 2019**. Teams that register after **Saturday 31st August 2019** may incur a **\$60 late entry fee**.

Fees

Player Registration Fee: **\$110 per player (\$80 for u/18 players)**

Registrations after **Round 7** will be at a reduced fee of \$80 (\$60 for U/18)
There is no limit on how many players you can register.

To register your team, you must complete the registration form with a **MINIMUM of 8 PLAYERS** and **pay a minimum deposit of \$880** (you must indicate what players the registration payment is for)

ALL PLAYER FEE'S MUST BE PAID BEFORE THE COMPETITION STARTS.

TEAMS THAT HAVE ALL FEE'S PAID FOR ALL REGISTERED PLAYERS PRIOR TO THE COMPETITION STARTING WILL RECEIVE 3 BONUS POINTS.

All players are advised to have **PRIVATE HEALTH INSURANCE** as the coverage under the standard insurance is limited. Standard insurance does not cover loss of wages.

Teams can purchase 'Loss of Income Insurance' for your team at a low cost of **\$110.00 (incl GST)**. This can only be done on a team basis not individual. Forms are available in the committee room.

Draws/Grading

Draft grades will be issued by 15th September 2019, an organisers meeting will be held on **Thursday 19th September 2019 at 7.15pm** at The Kingsway fields. This will be the only opportunity to discuss grading.

Insurance Summary

- **All players are advised to have PRIVATE HEALTH INSURANCE as the coverage under the standard insurance is limited.**
- **If you are under the influence of any alcohol/drugs/medication at time of injury – you are not insured and cannot claim insurance.**
- All claims carry an excess of \$200
- For insurance cover information, read back of team registration form 'conditions of play'
- **The basic insurance policy covers you for death (inc permanent disability) and non-Medicare medicals (i.e physio, dental etc). It does not include loss of income cover.**
- **You can purchase 'Loss of Income Insurance' for your team at a low cost of \$110.00 (incl GST). This can only be done on a team basis not individual. Forms are available in the committee room.**

NOTES

When filling out Registration forms please take note of the following:

- If submitting a registration form, all registration forms must be completed and signed by each player. Prior to each player signing the registration form they **MUST** read the accompanying sheet that lists the insurance details. **Only NEW PLAYERS or players who have changed addresses/phone number need to complete these details on the registration sheet. Returning players only need to enter their NAME, Date of Birth and sign the team registration form.**
- Teams and player who register online **DO NOT** need to complete a registration form
- Players must be **15 years old before** they can register and play in an adult team.
- Photo ID must be produced when signing on for finals or when requested by an official.
- All teams must consist of a **minimum of 8 players.**
- Players who withdraw may be de-registered. Once a player has played **one or more games NO REFUNDS** will be given. There is a \$15 administration fee for players withdrawing after being registered but having played no games.
- Registrations can be made at any time during the season. Players **MUST** play a **minimum of 5 games** to qualify for the finals series.
- Only players registered in a team may play for that team. Penalties for teams playing players not registered in their team will be severe. Should you need substitute players please see the competition organiser **BEFORE THE GAME STARTS.**
- All teams may play **at any time slot** during the season. Every effort is made to even out the number of games played at each time slot, **but no guarantee is given.**
- Players may register in more than one team on the one evening **BUT no guarantee is given that games will not clash.**
- The registration of **ANY** player in **ANY** team is at the discretion of the committee.
- You **must indicate if a player is a Rep Player or not.** This means a Rep Player at **ANY OZTAG** association. Any team found not identifying rep players will be subject to sanctions as the committee decides, including **re-grading or withdrawal of the player (no refunds will be issued).**
- You must indicate if a player is U/18 to receive the relevant discounted fee.

INSURANCE

For as player to be covered by insurance they must either have registered online or be listed on the team registration sheet, which they must also have signed. Players should look at carrying their own insurance, as the Oztag Player Insurance Policy is limited.

Organisers please note:

- if you have new players or existing players that have changed address, then they must make the changes on the team registration sheet OR update their details online

FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH ANY OF THE ABOVE CONDITIONS MAY RESULT IN YOUR TEAM NOT BEING ACCEPTED INTO THE COMPETITION

FILL IN PLAYERS

We understand that at times be difficult to have all players turn up so to assist teams we allow fill in players. The rules are:

- Fill in's can only be done after Round 3.
- Each fill in player **MUST** pay a **\$5** fill-in fee, which covers filling in for **1** game only. They **MUST** report to the committee room, register and signon **BEFORE** playing.
- If they wish to play another game they **MUST** report to the committee room and pay a further \$5 and signon **BEFORE** the game
- The player can play a **MAXIMUM** of 2 games as a fill in player after which they must pay the balance of a full registration.
- Penrith Oztag reserves the right to reject a fill in player for any reason.
- Penrith Oztag Association reserves the right to alter these conditions as we see fit.

REGISTRATION DEALS

If an organiser provides

1. A **fully completed*** team registration of at **least 12 players** (incl. organiser)
2. All money for all players listed on registration form

by 24th August 2019 – The Team Organiser gets free entry (Register 12 pay for 11)

Note: Should you withdraw players after registering you will not receive a refund for the withdrawal if team numbers fall below 12. (This means your team numbers need to stay at or above 12 – incl. organiser)

If you enter a **fully completed*** team registration **with at least 10 players** and **fully paid by 30th August 2019** you will receive a **\$50 discount**.

* A fully completed team registration means:

- **All players' details completed correctly** – only new players or players with change of details needs to complete the address and phone number details. **Existing players MUST have completed Name, DOB and have signed the form** OR have completed their online registration.
- **All NEW players must complete address, DOB, phone number and player's signatures** on entry form in the correct fields OR have completed their online registration.
- **All team details** completed at the top of the form, including at least one contact phone number AND an email address OR have completed the team registration online.

Fully paid means you pay the full amount in one transaction. Having part payments from individual players through EFTPOS, Cash and Direct Deposit means a lot of extra work for us. If you can get all the money together and pay it you get the discount.

The above bonuses also apply for ONLINE registrations and payments. For ONLINE registrations the players must be registered and fully paid for in accordance with the above numbers and dates for the organiser to receive the discount.

There will be **NO exceptions** to this requirement to receive the bonuses. You can only receive one of the above bonuses. If in any doubt, please call us on 0421448158.

- **6 teams min** – the committee will decide which teams are accepted if more than 6 teams nominate. If less than 6 teams the committee will assess options and discuss with teams.
- * **Prizemoney will be reduced if less than 6 teams. Prizemoney may be increased if more than 6 teams in the competition.**
- **Maximum 12 players per team.**
- Fill-ins or casual rego's – teams may use ONE player as a fill in or a casual registration to bring total team number to 8 players. Fill-ins and casual rego's for Premier Tag are at the committee's discretion.
- Late registrations are at committee discretion – teams can't exceed max number of player
- Must play 60% of games to qualify for finals, unless a replacement rego (see below).
- Replacement registrations are permitted due to injury or illness or any other matter the committee deems appropriate. The player being replaced cannot return to the team. Any replacements made after Round 7 must play **ALL** available games to qualify for finals. Replacement registrations are **ALL** subject to committee approval.

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CONDITIONS OF PLAY, INCLUDING PLAYER INSURANCE COVER Appendix 10



The Oztag competition is organised and run by The Australian Oztag Sports Association Inc ("Oztag").

Oztag offers to provide access to the competition to Players on provision by Players of the registration fee and agreement to these Conditions of Play.

As a Player, I agree and understand that, subject to these Conditions,

1. I play at my own risk. If I have not signed the registration form, I will not be covered by any insurance and I play completely at my own risk. Qualification of any team for the semi finals will depend upon validly signed and completed registration forms for all Players being submitted.
2. I will not wear football boots with screw in type studs (metal, nylon or spikes).
3. I will wear shoes suitable to playing the sport whilst playing - I will not play in bare feet.
4. I will not wear jewellery (which includes men's watches) while playing.
5. I will not talk to the referee unless I am the captain of a team.
6. I will not sledge either the opposition or my own team members. This is a major offence and will result in me being sent off.
7. I must comply with the referee's directions and decisions.
8. I must play in official Oztag shorts.
9. I must be 15 years of age to play in in adult competition.
9. Any injury I sustain must be reported to the first aid officer on the night of the injury. Claims may be rejected if the injury is not reported on the night.
10. All teams must wear numbered shirts with numbers either clearly identified on both sleeves or with one large number on the back of the shirt.
11. Changes may occur to the competition during the competition. Information regarding any changes will be published on the website (www.penrithoztag.com.au) or on the Penrith Oztag FaceBook page. Teams & players are recommended to check these notices as these changes may affect them.

Injury Insurance & Liability

1. Oztag has arranged injury insurance cover ("Player Insurance") for Players through Sportscover (Australia) Pty Limited ACN 006 637 903 under authority from American Re-insurance Company ARBN 000 857 698. Policy terms are available to all Players and will be provided on reasonable notice to Oztag. A summary of the Player Insurance cover is set out below.
2. Players acknowledge that there is a real possibility of injury in playing in the Oztag competition. The most common injuries are ankle and knee injuries and broken bones but may include any form of injury, including in rare cases, death.
3. Players who desire more comprehensive or other insurance cover must obtain this cover prior to playing. It is up to each Player to determine whether they require further cover in addition to the Player Insurance before they play.

As a Player, I warrant that:

1. I am in a fit state of health to play.
2. I will not be under the influence of alcohol or drugs that may adversely affect me while playing.
3. I have no pre-existing medical or other conditions which might cause me injury or be aggravated by playing.
4. I have read and understood these Conditions of Play.
5. I will comply with these Conditions of Play.

I acknowledge that if this information is incorrect, the Player Insurance may be voided.

Release

1. As a Player, I acknowledge that the Player Accident Insurance may be my only recourse to recover damages for personal injury.
2. I hereby RELEASE Oztag and its associated parties, including without limitation, its members, officers, servants and agents, contractors and referees including any other person engaged by Oztag in any capacity ("the Oztag Parties" or, individually, "Oztag Party") from all liability for loss of any nature, including without limitation, all personal injury, including assault or battery, economic loss sustained from personal injury, damage to property, whether arising out of negligence, breach of any statutory duty, breach of contract or at common law.
3. I acknowledge and represent that any Oztag Party regardless of their connection with me may rely on this release. This release from liability applies unless specifically prohibited by statute.
4. Notwithstanding paragraph 14, Oztag expressly excludes all liability for death or personal injury to any Player in so far as such liability is capable of being the subject of any implied warranty under section 74 of the Trade Practices Act 1974 (Cth) and any other state or territory legislation having a similar purpose.
5. Paragraph 10 and the "Important Notice" on the registration form constitutes a risk warning for the purposes of the Civil Liability Act 2002 NSW and any other legislation having a similar purpose.
6. These Conditions of Play represent the entire agreement and understanding between Oztag and the Player and bind the Player's heirs, successors and assigns.
7. Oztag will not waive or vary any of these Conditions of Play unless it does so by notice in writing.
